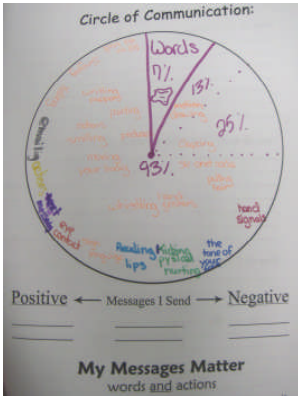

He was a troubled 5th grader who struggled with reading and school work. He was often in trouble on the playground and got to see the principal way too much. Last year he daily banged his head against his desk because he was so frustrated.

Over the months that I was teaching Walkin' The Talk he refused to write in his workbook, though he participated when we had group interactions. I wasn't sure he was "getting it," but after about 6 months he shared in a support group about the night his dad was severely abusing his mom again,...



He wasn't visiting the principal nearly so often anymore and his grades began to improve. I believe he learned the keys to unlock the truth and integrity within himself that will sustain him in the years to come.
